

Hancock Lee, Born 1653 died 25th May 1709 at "Ditchley, Northumberland Co".

SARAH ALLERTON, dau of Isaac Allerton, Granddau of Fear Brewster and Isaac Allerton of the Mayflower from who descended ZACHARY TAYLOR, 12th president of the U.S., and General Richard Taylor, CSA, and the Ditchley line.

FRANCIS LIGHTFOOT LEE, Born at Stratford 14 October 1734, died at "Menokin" in Jan 1797, bur<sup>d</sup> at Mt. Airy. Burgess from both Loudoun and Richmond Counties, co-founder of Leesburg, and Signer of the Declaration of Independence.

William Lee, born at Stratford 31st Aug 1739 died at Greenspring 27th Jun 1795, bur<sup>d</sup> at Jamestown. Merchant in London, first American Alderman of London, Commercial Agent of the Continental Congress to France, and its representative at the Courts of Berlin and Vienna.

Arthur Lee, born Stratford 21st December 1740, died 12th December 1792 at "Lansdowne", Middlesex Co. Holder of degree in both medicine and law, he was appointment Commissioner to France in 1776 and signed the treaty of Alliance with France in 1778. Member of the Confederation Congress and Chairman of the Board of the Treasury (Secretary of the Treasury) from 1784 to 1789. Never married.

HENRY LEE, born 1729 at "Lee Hall" afsd died 15 Aug 1787 at "Sully", Fairfax County, bur<sup>d</sup> at "Leesylvania". Burgess, County Lieutenant and State Senator From whom descended the Leesylvania Line.

Matilda Lee, dau of Philip Ludwell Lee.

HENRY LEE, born at Leesylvania afsd. 29 Jan 1756, died at "Dungeness", Cumberland Island, Ca. 25th March 1818 Bur<sup>d</sup> in Lee Chapel, Lexington, VA. Brilliant cavalry leader in the Revolution, three times Governor of Virginia, Member of Confederation and U.S. Congress, died a martyr to freedom of the press.

ROBERT EDWARD LEE, born at Stratford 19 Jan 1807, died at Lexington 12th Oct 1870. Graduate of West Point, Superintendent of West Point, Colonel U.S. 2d Cavlary, Commanding General, Army of Northern Virginia, C.S.A., and the Armies of the Confederacy. President of Washington College, Bur<sup>d</sup> in Lee Chapel, Lexington.
