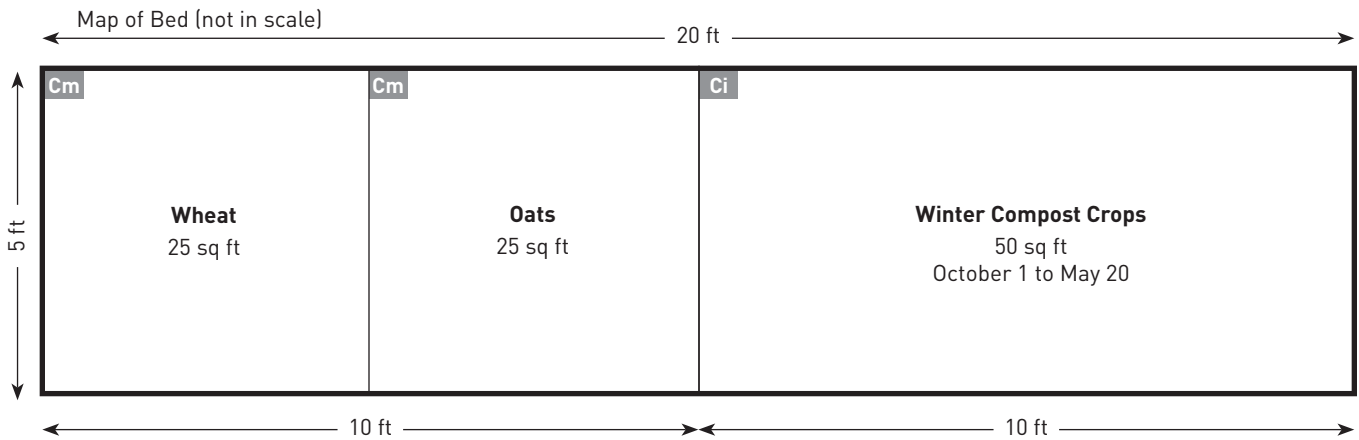


Plant winter compost crops. One good mix (recipe per 100 square feet) should be planted about 6 weeks before first hard frost date. It is made up of:

- 2 ounces (about 1¹/₃ cups) hard red spring wheat—transplant or broadcast.
- .4 ounce (about 1 tablespoon) cereal rye—transplant or broadcast.
- .62 ounce (about 5¹/₄ teaspoons) vetch broadcast after soaking seed overnight. (Mix seed with a small amount of dry soil before broadcasting so seeds do not stick together.
- 1 ounce (about 1¹/₄ cup) Banner fava beans sown on 21-inch centers—transplant or direct sow.
